Our Post Chaplain

The office of chaplain in the Veterans of Foreign Wars is an important one although the person in that position is seldom given adequate recognition.

At Woodstock, Marvin Bohnhoff served as chaplain for 11 years. Health problems prompted him to relinquish the position last month when Howard Engstrom was installed as chaplain.

Bohnhoff has been an assistant pastor and volunteer at Our Savior Lutheran Church at Grayslake and was active in Bible study at St. John's Church in Island Lake.

Engstrom served with the Eighth Army Air Force in England during World War II.

"The chaplain's duties include participation in funerals when the VFW rifle squad is asked to honor a veteran," said Engstrom. "In the first few weeks in this office I've been privileged to participate in four funerals honoring veterans. With World War II veterans dying at the rate of about 1,500 a day throughout the United States, participation in funerals is an increasing responsibility."

Engstrom said he also visits members recuperating from an illness in their homes. The Rev. Cecil C. Urch was pastor of the Presbyterian Church in Woodstock when he served as Post 5040 VFW's first chaplain, 1946-1947. Engstrom was a deacon with the Evangelical Free Church of America in the 1960s and a board member in the 1970s.

Soon after Engstrom and his wife Marian moved to Woodstock in 1982, Engstrom became a staff member at Sunset Manor and Woodstock Christian Care, ministries of the Free Methodist Church. "I've been involved in Christian ministry for years," observed Engstrom. "My stewardship included speaking at Free Methodist churches in the Midwest and contributing to the Christian atmosphere at the senior citizen homes."



Engstrom, 83, now works in public relations and fund raising at Family Alliance. This Woodstock facility provides daytime care for adults.

The VFW chaplain's duties also include leading prayers at Post meetings and at Memorial Day, Veterans Day and Pearl Harbor Day observances.

The list of members who has occupied this office at Post 5040 reads like a "Who's Who" of community leaders. Following Rev. Urch as chaplain was Elmer Clausen, 1948 through 1950. Dwayne Raney answered the call in 1955 and also in 1961 and 1965. Jim Shoemaker was chaplain in 1974. He later served as Woodstock's mayor, 1985-1992. Chuck Mathey, a member of the rifle squad today, was chaplain, 1976 through 1978. Another man who filled this position with distinction was Dominic Amico. He was in the office from 1979 through 1992.
