

I have been very disturbed by the negative reports that have been published in our news letter. It is time to clear the air. I had made my statements about the kitchen losing money only by seeing the records that our club manager had given to me. The August reports stated that we had made anywhere from \$13 to \$24 on each Wednesday or Friday; this was over the cost of the food and the labor. My statement that we were losing money, took into consideration, gas to prepare the meal, light to cook by, heating or cooling of the guests and the cleaning-up of the room the next morning. This had nothing to do with building maintenance. But I must add, now a month and a half later, the kitchen is doing great and easily covering its costs plus some extra.

Because we had two more frames for patches to be made and paid-for, I suggested to the Directors that we ask the other two veterans organizations to donate the money to have them completed. The American Legion immediately sent a check. The Marine Corps League instead sent a note saying they would gladly pay for one frame on the condition that it contain only Marine Corp shoulder patches. At our Monday night meeting (10/16), we had a great turnout (the Bears played the same night, too). We were visited by a District officer, Ray Bacovitch came in to do the annual check of the books, I am happy to say our Quartermaster received an "A". A report was made on the selling of our bingo machine, and it was decided that the money should be placed in the building maintenance fund for the repainting of the outside of the building.

About two weeks ago I received a call from Dwayne Raney volunteering to be my adjutant.




