VFW National Home Awareness week March 25-31, 2007

For almost 80 years, the VFW National Home for Children (VFWNHC) has reached out and touched the lives of thousands of children and families of veterans across the nation.

The VFWNHC in Eaton Rapids, Michigan provides services for children when the child's parent, grandparent, or great grandparent is, or if deceased, at the time of death was a member in good standing of the Veterans of Foreign wars or Ladies Auxiliary, and the child's custodian cannot provide an adequate home for the child. Services are also available for children of active duty military service personnel, regardless of current VFW membership or eligibility, who are not able to provide adequate care for their children through the approved family plan arrangement.

Children living at the VFWNHC receive the following on-campus services: educational support, recreational opportunities, and individual and "family" counseling. All food, housing, and utilities are provided. The National Home maintains contacts with local community agencies and professionals to provide individual psychological services, and both specialized and routine medical, dental, and eye care services. Clothing is purchased locally and children attend Eaton Rapids Public Schools.

Since the programs receive no government funding, contributions from Posts, Auxiliaries, Military Order of the Cootie Pup Tents and individual donors are critical for the VFWNHC to maintain its programs and the campus. Contributions of any amount are always appreciated and may be designated for a specific program. Moreover, you can be assured that your gift will serve the children at the National Home.


